Short Biography

Martine Labbé is honorary professor at the Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB). Until 2019 she was professor of Operations Research at the Computer Science Department of the Faculty of Sciences. Her main research area is discrete optimization, including graph theory and integer programming problems and with a particular emphasis on location and network design problems. She is also specialised in bilevel optimization and studies pricing problems and Stackelberg games.

She serves or has served on the editorial boards of Discrete Optimization, International Transactions in Operational Research, Journal on Combinatorial Optimization, Journal of Optimization Theory and Applications, Operations Research, Operations Research Letters and Transportation Science. She was the Editor in Chief of the EURO Journal on Computational Optimization from 2012 to 2020.

She is the author or coauthor of more than 150 papers published in international journals.

In 2007-2008, she was president of EURO, the Association of European Operational Research Societies. She was Vice-Chair of the SIAM Activity Group on Optimization (SIAG/OPT) in 2014 and 2015.

In 2019 she was awarded the EURO Gold Medal.
